In the Milford/Minersville area, water users who irrigate using both surface and ground water and whose groundwater rights are insufficient to cover the entire extent of the irrigation are required to have a functioning water meter on all groundwater sources. The purpose of the meter is to ensure that the limits of the groundwater rights are not exceeded. Water users who irrigate solely from groundwater or whose groundwater rights are sufficient to cover the entirety of their irrigation are not required to install meters because their water use is regulated by mapping the irrigated acreage.

You have been identified as a water user fitting this description; your groundwater rights are not sufficient to cover the total of the land that you irrigate with your well and with your Rocky Ford shares.

As required under Section 73-5-54 Utah Code Annotated, you are hereby notified that your well(s) must be equipped with a functional and accurate meter prior to using well water and not later than June 1, 2008. The meter must be capable of reading the flow rate and have a totalizer showing the total amount pumped; both should read in standard units of water measurement*.



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Once the meter installation is complete, please **contact the Milford Water Commissioner, LaVar Davis at (435) 387-5032, to conduct an inspection and initial meter reading.** If the well is not in compliance by the above stated deadline, the State Engineer will issue and Order to Cease the Use of Water.

*In accordance with state law: 73-1-2. (Standard) Unit of measurement -- Of flow -- Of volume: The standard unit of measurement of the flow of water shall be the discharge of one cubic foot per second of time, which shall be known as a second-foot; and the standard unit of measurement of the volume of water shall be the acre-foot, being the amount of water upon an acre covered one foot deep, equivalent to 43,560 cubic feet.
