MEMORANDUM

TO: Hubert C. Lambert

SUBJECT: Subdivision Development on Parowan Water Shed

On November 24, 1969, we held a hearing as requested on the above mentioned matter. A list of those who attended the hearing is on the last page of the enclosed transcript.

There was no new or additional information brought into this hearing. Mr. LeFevre did not have evidence to support his claim that the water originally flowed, naturally, onto the Prince and Ranger Flat. He did have some photographs depicting a "bubbling" brook but there was nothing in the photos that tied it to this area.

As I stated earlier, there is actual evidence in the field that the stream had been diverted from it's natural channel and I believe that the Parowan Water Users have a legitimate protest.

Please advise this office on the action to be taken as soon as possible. It is probably too late, unless this good weather holds out for a few more days, to do anything about it before the start of the 1970 irrigation season.
