

Minutes of the Parowan Valley Water Users

February 5, 1970

The second annual meeting of the Parowan Valley Users was held in the Iron County Court House, Parowan, Utah. Chairman Lyle Halterman presiding.

A report was made by Don Norseth of the State Engineers Dept. in regard to the annual water supply. At the present time the water outlook will be below normal unless have an increase precipitation during the balance of the spring.

Minutes for 1969 meeting were approved as read.

Financial report issued by Richard Pexton of the State Engineers Office, was approved as read.

Commissioner Norm Day gave a report on water use for 1969 and made recommendation for the ensuing year, as outlined in his annual report.

Budget: The following was recommended as the budget for 1970:

\$ 675.00 Commissioners salary.
\$ 25.00 for bond and insurance.
\$ 175.00 travel expenses
\$ 100.00 Commissioners report
\$ 200.00 Calculator fund
\$ 25.00 Miscellaneous expense.
\$1250.00 total

A motion was made by Hal Mitchell, and seconded by Alton Pendleton, to add the Parowan Center Creek to the duties of the commissioner and that the field stream users will pay the amount of \$100.00 for 1970 as a cost of measuring said water use.

A motion by Hal Mitchell, and seconded by D Robinson, that a commissioner for 1970 be selected, as in 1969, by the officers of the water users and recommended to the State Engineer unanimously.

Note: Mr. Norseth requested this recommendation be in the State Engineers office within two weeks from date.

A motion by Gayle Wood, at 11:10 a.m. and seconded by Hal Mitchel to adjourn. Passed unanimously.
