

## WATER SUPPLY

The 2002 water year in the spring looked to be short for filling the reservoirs. The dry fall of 2001 caused the snow melt to sink into the ground instead of ending up in the river where it could be captured for storage. With the expected low runoff Weber Basin began using their Ogden River water supply for exchange to the Weber River in May instead of late June or early July in normal years.

## DISTRIBUTION

The waters of the Ogden River were distributed according to the Ogden River Decree of April 1948 in the case of Plain City Irrigation Company, Plaintiff vs. Hooper Irrigation Company, North Ogden Irrigation Company and all other claimants.

Priority cut off dates for Ogden River distribution were as follows:

May	5	Pineview water users began using storage.
May	29	Weber Basin began using exchange water.
June	10	Cut lower river rights to low.
June	17	Upper Valley began using Causey Storage.
June	20	Cut 1867 rights off.
June	25	Cut 50% 1858 rights off.
July	20	Put on 1858 rights.
Aug.	1	Cut 50% of 1858 rights.
