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WATER RIGHTS

Mr. Norseth welcomed everyone to the meeting of the Ogden River Water Rights Committee and indicated the Soil Conservation Divisions snow survey reflects an average of 13" of water or 159% of normal. At Ben Lomond 20" of water or 165% of normal. At Monty Cristo 18.2" of water or 192% of normal. This is way above average and we should have a good year.

Mr. Norseth then turned the meeting over to Mr. Samuel H. Barker, Chairman Ogden River Rights Committee.

Mr. Barker called the meeting to order and indicated that Mr. Heslop was acting as secretary.

Mr. Berghout read last years minutes of the Associations' January 1980 meeting with the state engineer representative and they were approved.

The next order of business, Mr. Norseth presented the 1981 financial statement:
Receipts \$12,094.20 Expenditures \$11,792.26

Balance of Distribution Trust Funds, December 31, 1981: \$2,408.62

Chairman Barker presented the proposed 1982 association budget (copy attached).

Mr. Berghout pointed out that this budget is less than last years and since this appointment was terminated he and Mr. Southwick had agreed on the terms of \$250.00 per month to finish up his appointment. Mr. Jensen moved and Mr. Barrett seconded that whatever agreement Mr. Southwick made with Mr. Berghout be accepted.

It was recommended by Chairman Barker that Boyd Heslop and John Wilson be appointed Ogden River Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner, respectively. Mr. Norseth accepted their appointment.

Mr. Berghout reported on 1981 operations as follows:

The irrigation season started out at some 212 CFS on May 3 and rising to 256 CFS by June 2 and steadily declining to a low of 48 CFS by September 14. Stream flows in 1981 on the North Fork, Wolf Creek and South Fork were about one-third to a little over one-half of the 1980 flows. This was an indication of this years water irrigation situation. Pine View Dam was short of being filled by 19300 acre feet. Causey was filled only by transferring 3310 acre feet from Pine View Dam. October 5 storms ended the 1981 water year.

Mr. Baker suggested that the address of the Lynne Irrigation Co. be changed and that Nick Baker would be president of said company for one more year, then Brenden James would be president for the next two years.

Mr. Barker turned meeting back to Mr. Norseth. There being no further business for consideration, meeting was adjourned.
