MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE STATE ENGINEER WITH  
THE OGDEN RIVER WATER RIGHTS ASSOCIATION FOR 1974

The meeting of the Ogden River Water Rights Association with the State Engineer was called to order at 3:00 P.M. by Engineer Don Norseth. The meeting was held at the City and County Building, January 8, 1974.

Mr. Norseth noted that Mr. Dee Hansen is the present State Engineer. Following comments, he turned the meeting over to Edward H. Southwick. Mr. Southwick introduced seven of the nine directors who were present at this meeting.

Financial statement attached herewith was read and accepted following motion by Harvey Stone; seconded by Horace Rhees.

The 1974 budget was presented and accepted following motion by Wayne Winegar; seconded by James Randall.

Mr. Southwick announced the Association recommendation that Mr. Floyd Barnett and Mr. Leonard Berghout be retained as Water Commissioner and Deputy respectively for 1974. Confirmation was given by Engineer Norseth.

Commissioner Barnett discussed water problems including new ones created by developments at Twelfth and Wall and the new inter-state access in the area of 21st street.

Engineer Norseth commented that if flood water problems increase with development, legal relief can be obtained. He noted that flood water control authority rests with the County Commissioners.

The balance of the meeting was given to individual ditch problems and discussion from the floor.

Meeting ajourned.
