Dear Sue,

I am writing in reference to SEAA No. 1304 requiring the installation of accurate measurement devices to be installed on diversions 1, 2, and 5. This action requires compliance no later than May 15, 2009.

During the first part of the 2008 irrigation season; debris in pipeline 1 disrupted flow to the meter. The meter functioned properly for the remainder of the season once the debris was removed. The Agency feels confident that the meter installed in MIC diversion 1 is operating properly and does not need to be replaced.

The paddle wheel insertion meters installed in diversions 2 & 5 are subject to low flows and debris causing unreliable results. The Agency recommends they be replaced with magnetic insertion meters. The operating parameters of these meters allow for low flow measurement and they have no moving parts that would be affected by debris.

Due to the high cost of meter replacement; the Agency would like to replace the meter on diversion 5 and operate it for 90 days to insure that it functions properly before installing a second meter in diversion 2.

The Agency is requesting a 90 day extension to the May 15, 2009 compliance date of SEAA No. 1304.
