MILL CREEK DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

A meeting of the Mill Creek Distribution System was held on Monday, August 8, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. in Moab, Utah. The records of the Water Commissioner, Robert Byrnes, were reviewed for the period of March to July for the current water year. The Commissioner's travel vouchers were also reviewed and approved with some modification for June and July. In reviewing the budget, it was found that more than the allocation for travel had already been expended. Therefore, after some discussion, it was agreed that an additional assessment of \$600.00 should be made by the State Engineer to cover the projected travel expenses to the end of the irrigation season. Chairman, Curtis Young agreed with the supplemental assessment as did Janie Walker. They were the only board members present at the meeting. This situation was previously discussed at a board meeting when all of the members were present. However, a specific amount was not established at that time.

It was further agreed that Commissioner Byrnes would make one trip through the system each week through the end of September, at which time his contract would be completed for the 1983 water year.

The meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
