Dear Mr. Kuiper

For some time we have been discussing the priority schedule on Pot Creek between Colorado and Utah with particular reference to the establishment of a Colorado period of use for irrigation from April 1 to October 31.

We have reviewed the schedule sent by you and note that there have been fairly significant changes in the Utah rights and that the Green River Determination, which is an interlocutory decree pertaining to these rights, has some limitations as to the changing of period of use against storage.

In our recent conversation you stated that you did not have a book on the rights on the Pot Creek drainage in Utah. Therefore, enclosed is a copy of this determination. Also we have prepared a priority schedule of the Utah rights only as they are now. When you have had a chance to review it, please get in touch, and we can commingle the Colorado rights and prepare a joint priority schedule.
