

EXTENSION AGREEMENT

This extension agreement is entered into this 1st day of April, 1959, by and between the State of Colorado and the State of Utah, acting by and through their officers thereunto duly authorized, and the following recitals are made as the basis for this agreement:

1. That under date of April 1, 1958, a Memorandum of Understanding and of Tentative Agreement was entered into by and between the State of Colorado and the State of Utah by their duly authorized officers.

2. That by said memorandum a priority schedule of water rights was tentatively adopted for the basis of distribution of water from Pot Creek and a joint water commissioner was appointed.

3. That operation under said Memorandum was the subject of review, as therein provided, at a meeting in Vernal, Utah, on March 4, 1959, by representatives of both contracting parties and, distribution having been determined to have been both necessary and proper, a continuation of said Memorandum was there recommended by unanimous action.

4. That said Memorandum and Tentative Understanding contemplated an annual review and extension thereof by joint action of the State Engineers of Utah and Colorado.

From the foregoing recitals, the following agreement is reached:

1. That the said Memorandum and Tentative Agreement entered into on April 1, 1958, shall continue in full effect for the year 1959 and for succeeding years by mutual exchange of letters of approval by the respective State Engineers.

2. That the provision for annual review shall remain operative and modifications of the said attached priority schedule may be agreed upon by the respective State Engineers without necessity for re-execution of said original Memorandum.
