The purpose of this letter is to temporarily suspend the Diversion Regulation, Measuring Device and Headgate Notice numbered SEAA 1074 and dated August 30, 2004.

After further consideration of the situation and water distribution issues in the Round Valley area, the State Engineer has determined that the scope of the regulation and the requirement to install measuring devices should be expanded to include the entire valley. Unfortunately, other higher priority issues prevent us from implementing regulation on that scale in Round Valley at this time.

Therefore, the requirement to install measuring devices will be held in abeyance until such time as the State Engineer determines to require measuring devices throughout the Round Valley area. You will be notified at a future date when we plan to implement measurement and regulation in the area.

However, the installation and use of measuring devices is always a good step in the proper management of water use and we would not discourage you from proceeding to install accurate and dependable measuring devices.
