As I discussed with you this past summer, the first two paychecks you received when you were first appointed Water Commissioner were below the minimum amount whereby you did not qualify for the Utah Retirement System Pension. You will be getting a check for the amount not invested, and also receive a 1099 tax form where you will need to pay taxes on this amount being returned to you.

To get you onto the retirement system, I need you to resign, as Water Commissioner and we will reappoint you in February 2012. I will personally insure the paycheck amounts will qualify you for retirement as the committee desires. Please sign and return the attached letter to our office.
