INSTALLATION OF CONTROLLING WORKS ON DIVERSION

Dear Mr. Feeney:

Our records show that you own a water right in Beaver Creek east of Huntsville. A measuring device is present there but no controls exist to prevent water from entering your diversion when you are not entitled to divert. Pursuant to Section 73-5-4 of the Utah Code, all users of water are required to have operable headgates or other controlling works so that the river commissioner can regulate their diversion. **This correspondence constitutes notification that you must install a suitable headgate within thirty days of the date hereof.** Also in Section 73-5-4 of the Utah Code, is the provision for the State Engineer to forbid the use of water until the user complies with this order or the controlling works may be installed by the State Engineer and the cost billed to the owner. One of these provisions will be pursued if you do not comply with this request.
