
Dear Mr. Haycock,

As of this date I have notified E. Blaine Johnson, the Ogden River Water Commissioner, to cease crediting power water to our storage. According to the February Storage Report, Ogden River Water Users' Association was credited with 27,751 Ac. Ft. of storage of which 15,236 is power water. Our Records show that from March 1 to March 15 an additional 6,100 Ac. Ft. has been stored, of which 3,635 Ac. Ft. is UP&L water (at the 125 c.f.s. rate). The remaining 2,465 Ac. Ft. is Ogden River Water Users' entitlement water. It appears at this time we will be able to fill our storage with entitlement water if the runoff is as predicted.

We would still like to reserve the right to recall storing power water if it becomes necessary.

Weber Basin Water Conservancy District will be storing power water consisting of the 125 c.f.s. inflow and 200 c.f.s. of storage from Ogden River Water Users', which was going to be released to UP&L, until further notice.
