

1980 Santa Clara Distribution
System Annual Meeting.

Minutes of the annual meeting of the Santa Clara River Waterusers Association held on 13 Feb. 1980 at the Washington County Courthouse.

Presiding: Don Norseth, State Engineers Office

Conducting: Rudgar McArthur, Vice President, Waterusers Association

Don Norseth gave a preliminary report of the water outlook for the State, which was good.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved on a motion by Truman Bowler, seconded by Ivan Hunt.

Financial report was given by Mr. Norseth and approved on a motion by Floyd Ence, seconded by Truman Bowler.

Commissioners Report was called for and given by commissioner Rodney Leavitt and accepted on a motion by Ivan Hunt seconded by LeGrand Frei.

After a discussion by the members a motion was made by Floyd Ence, that unless the corrections suggested by the Commissioner are corrected by the Companies and in the opinion of the water commissioner can be done, are not completed by July 1st of 1980, the commissioner shut off the water to the companies not complying. Seconded by LeGrand Frei, Motion carried.

Discussion was called for on recommendations for water commissioner . Motion by Floyd Ence the the rules be suspended and Rodney Leavitt be recommended to the State Engineer as Commissioner. Seconded by Eugene Chadburn. Motion Carried.

Motion by Floyd Ence, Seconded by Sherman Chadburn that the Commissioners travel expense be increased to \$3700.00 per year. Motion Carried.

Motion by Truman Bowler that the budget be set the same as last year, with the exception of the Commissioners travel expence be increased by \$600.00. Seconded by Ivan Hunt. Motion carried.

The silt problem at the Gunlock reservoir was discussed at length.
