The main purpose of the meeting was a discussion of the 50% agreement developed June 15, 1966, as a result of a meeting held at St. George June 9, 1966.

There were three lines of discussion pertinent to the distribution of waters of Santa Clara Creek: One was that the 50% had worked satisfactorily and should be continued; another that a trial period should be utilized wherein Pine Valley would receive 100% of their water for the remainder of the year, and the third was that the system should be put back on the Santa Clara River Decree. After much discussion pro and con as to the merits of all three and lacking a unanimous opinion of the water users, a motion was made and passed that the system operate in the future on the Santa Clara River Decree.

The next item of business was a brief discussion as to the measuring device of the Newcastle Reservoir Company. It was stated by Mr. Gerald Stoker that as of August 1 if it was not installed court action was forth coming to stop diversion of water into the Newcastle Reservoir from the Santa Clara Creek.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
