

Dear Jerry:

The District has received a grant from the Bureau of Reclamation to install a telemetry system along the Santa Clara and Virgin rivers. This project will allow monitoring for approximately 36 sites. The information collected from the sites will then be published on a website accessible to all water users for their review. For the most part, stakeholders have been willing to cooperate; however, there are two companies that have refused the installation of a viable measuring flume and nominal monitoring equipment at their diversion(s).

Our hope in writing this letter is to respectfully request your assistance in requiring these companies to cooperate and allow the installation of a flume and/or supporting equipment to monitor the quantity of water taken at the diversions.

Here is a list of the following companies (with their site locations to be monitored) that are hindering the project's completion.

New Castle Irrigation Company	Grass Valley at the cross basin diversion
Pacific Corp Power Company	Power Flume at Baker Reservoir Veyo Flume & Power Company U-pipe Hwy 18 Flume Power Plant at Gunlock

In order to qualify for the grant reimbursement, the project needs to be completed by February 27, 2008 so, time is of the essence.
