Utah Power and Light Co. have their own backhoe and equipment they need to do the job. I, and many others have often seen the workers stopped at various homes in Veyo for hours visiting, during working hours, and with UP&L's automobile. I understand that there are only two of them to maintain the ditches, but they should make better use of their time, by doing the job they are hired to do.

I believe that it raises the electric bill, when the water is wasted when it could be producing electricity and when the employees are getting paid to maintain the ditch and don't.

I hope there will be some action taken on this matter.
