Lee Sim brought the meeting to order. Stan Adams read the minutes from the 1989 water user meeting. Leo Gillespie made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Don Ray Christensen seconded the motion. Motion carried. Lee Sim then reviewed the financial statement for 1989. The delinquent accounts were reviewed noting that the Randy Brunger assessment has not been paid for six years. Perry Jensen indicated that he would make the contacts needed to resolve this delinquency. Don Prestwich asked about the Central Utah Water Project monies. Lee Sim explained that the \$4500.00 outlined in the miscellaneous expenses is the Central Utah Water Project contribution. Stan Adams described the need for flow measurement records on the Sanpitch River System. A motion was made by Don Ray Christensen and seconded by Kristy Jensen to accept the financial report as read. Motion carried.

Lloyd Terry pointed out that Rodney Jay Petersons' account is not in the West Milburn Irrigation Company but is in the East Milburn Irrigation Company. Also, that Milburn Irrigation Company have a regulating reservoir on the South Sanpitch whereby they were diverting all of the water from that source. Stan Adams said that the State Engineers office would look into this to make sure the water rights are in order.

Perry Jensen gave his verbal report on the Upper Sanpitch River system stating that the system is in pretty good shape. However, the Brady Ditch has some erosion problems that need correcting. Perry concluded his report by saying that he does not have time to read the new measuring devices being installed on the system. Stan Adams mentioned that there will be a total of 8 stations on the Upper Sanpitch system this year. A motion was made by Don Ray Christensen and seconded by Leo Gillespie to accept Perrys' report as read. Motion carried.

Lee Sim then asked the water users to recommend a commissioner for 1990. Don Ray Christensen made a motion to nominate Perry Jensen as commissioner and Lowell Anderson as a deputy commissioner in charge of the new stations. Motion was seconded by Leo Gillespie. Motion carried.

The 1990 budget was discussed. Contractual services were set at \$3000.00 to take care of additional costs for Lowell Anderson and Ray Owens.

A motion was made by Kristy Jensen to set the budget at \$15500.00 which includes the \$4500.00 Central Utah Water Project money. Leo Gillespie seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Lee Sim asked if there are any changes in the directors. Don Prestwich commented that they will be the same as last year.

Glen Rasmussen said that Rock Dam needs two measuring devices. Stan Adams said that the State Engineers office would look at this site.

Lee Sim talked about distribution services the State Engineers office provides. The assessment work or accounting work for the 35 distribution systems in the State cost \$75000.00. The law states that this money can be included in the assessment to water users. Lee Sim stated that the State Engineers office is not looking forward to doing this but that it is a possibility.
