

Gentlemen:

As you are aware, the United States Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) will complete the Jordanelle Dam in the spring of 1993. The Central Utah Water Conservancy District (CUWCD) and USBR are desirous of storing water behind Jordanelle Dam starting about April 1, 1993, in an attempt to complete the first stage of filling this water year. The first stage filling criteria for Jordanelle Reservoir allows the reservoir to raise at an unrestricted rate from the outlet gates invert to elevation 5930 feet MSL and a maximum of 2 vertical feet per day from elevation 5930 feet MSL to elevation 6020 MSL. This equals approximately 44,000 acre-feet of water and will take an estimated 70 days. However, because runoff normally does not last 70 days and because the filling criteria restricts the amount of storage to 158 cfs at elevation 5930, CUWCD desires to extend the total days in which water could be stored in Jordanelle Reservoir. This could be made possible if 878 acre-feet of water stored in Trial Lake could be released before the 1993 runoff period, and stored in Jordanelle Reservoir. If Trial Lake does not fill and spill, the amount of water required to fill Trial Lake after it reached its maximum water surface elevation would be released from Jordanelle Reservoir at the request of the Trial Lake water users or the Provo River Commissioner.

We are asking you to cooperate with the District by allowing the release of 878 acre-feet of water from Trial Lake to be rediverted in Jordanelle Reservoir under the following conditions:

1. CUWCD will prepare the appropriate change application and receive approval from the State Engineer.

2. If Trial Lake does not fill or spill, CUWCD will replace from Jordanelle Reservoir water in sufficient quantity to replace the amount of water required to fill Trial Lake Reservoir from the maximum water surface elevation achieved during the spring of 1993 to the spill elevation of 9818.5 MSL up to a maximum of 878 acre-feet. If CUWCD is unable to replace any required water from Jordanelle Reservoir, CUWCD agrees to pay \$50.00 per acre-foot to the Trial Lake water users for any amount not replaced.

3. Water released from Trial Lake will only be released in quantities and amounts that would allow for the storage of such water under the Jordanelle Reservoir filling criteria.

4. 878 acre-feet of water currently stored in Trial Lake may be subject to the State Engineer's Utah Lake Distribution Plan. Any conversion of water in Trial Lake or Jordanelle Reservoir will be subject to State Engineer's approval.

It is acknowledged that the provisions contained in this letter are for the 1993 water year only. Jordanelle Reservoir is not yet operational as referred to in the Trial Lake Reconstruction Agreement, and the provisions contained in that agreement are not to be considered in effect upon approval of this letter. If this arrangement is acceptable and meets your approval, please so indicate in the space provided below.


