Enclosed is a copy of letter sent to the Provo River Commissioner regarding the distribution report for the period February 1 - 15, 1983.


The Association is still concerned with the Utah Power and Light Company balance carried over from August when the Power Company had no right to store water in Deer Creek Reservoir. It appears that the Commissioner is trying to establish some kind of right for the Power Company to store water during the non-irrigation season which by contract is not permitted.

The Association is also concerned about the exchange of Smith Ditch water for Rock Canyon water taken into Provo City mains.

The stipulation under A-7008 and Change Application 961 spell out how this exchange should be handled and the quantities to be used. However the Commissioner has not been handling the water in this fashion.

Perhaps a check should be made to see if the water going into Provo City mains has been reduced to 1.33 C.F.S. in accordance with Change 961. Also, no more than 0.6 C.F.S. can be used from the Smith Ditch for Rock Canyon exchange.
