Enclosed is a copy of letter sent to the Provo River Commissioner re the January 16-31, 1983 report.

Several errors were noted. Among them was the item of 12 acre feet of water which should be credited to the Association since it is in excess of the Power Company right.


The item of 62 acre feet credited to the Association for water which has gone past the Utah Power & Light Company dam, several miles below Deer Creek Dam, is confusing. How can water already past Deer Creek Dam be shown as a credit to storage in the reservoir.

The method of transferring Ontario Tunnel water from the Power Company to the Orem Treatment Plant is difficult to follow and a suggested format for keeping track of Orem Treatment Plant water was presented.

The Commissioner is still showing a Power Company carry-over of water from the irrigation season which we again protest as illegal.

Can we get this matter cleared up and corrections made to the report? These, we think, should be handled by issuance of an errata sheet.
