Dear Mr. Gleave: Re: Deer Creek and Forest Creek

In response to your letter, our records show the following rights and accounts:

Concerning Deer Creek, there is a decreed award for 3.0 second feet of water in the name of J. R. Jolley. This is under Water Right File 61-14. The records do not show an assessment account number for it. There is a copy of a deed on file indicating that Phil Allen of Antimony, Utah bought the right from Herbert Gleave, but there is no deed on file from Mr. Jolley to Mr. Gleave to complete the chain of title to Mr. Allen.

There is another decreed award for 0.5 second-foot that was originally in Deer Creek but was transferred to East Fork of Sevier River. It was originally in the name of William Gleave but was given to Robert Gleave in the Sevier River (Cox) Decree. It is located on Water Right File 61-2051, and there does not appear to be an assessment account on it. You would need to send in a copy of the deed or the probate decree conveying the property from Robert Gleave or his estate to you to update ownership.

Concerning Forest Creek, the only right on record is a decreed one for all of the flow of the creek up to 0.5 second-foot. This is in the name of Robert F. Hall and is under Water Right File 61-2154. There is no assessment account number with it.

Concerning 3.5 second-feet of water in East Fork for William Gleave, our records do not show any rights in William Gleave's name.

You are presently being billed under Assessment Account 52-2B for 0.5 second-foot of water from East Fork under decreed award to Charles Wiley (Water Right File 61-2059). You also have Assessment Account 52-84 for decreed awards from East Fork for 0.33 second-foot and 0.45 second-foot in the name of Alma Savage (Water Right

Files 61-2053 and 61-2060). In your letter you request payback payment. If you no longer use these water rights or they have been transferred to someone else, please let us know so that we can update the assessment rolls. If you believe you are paying for the other decreed rights that are described above, we do not show assessment accounts for them and thus have no refundable monies.

Copies of the awards mentioned in this letter are enclosed for your information.
