
As you are aware by now, I delivered a copy of my re-draft of the Stipulation in the A-L matter to Commissioner Roger Walker so that he could deliver it to you this morning and discuss it with you. The Stipulation was re-drafted in accordance with the conclusions reached during my telephone conversation with you the same night that the Presidents of the five defendant water companies met to consider whether or not they wanted to enter into the Stipulation. The Presidents of the five defendant water companies are agreeable to entering into the Stipulation as re-drafted.

I am sending copies of this letter and the re-drafted Stipulation to Attorneys Sam Cline, Ed Clyde and Dallin Jensen. I do want to make one comment concerning the re-draft of the Stipulation. It is my intention and understanding that if the Stipulation is signed and if either the Plaintiffs or the Defendants exercise their privilege of rescinding the Stipulation, that the River Commissioners will then administer the River under the same procedure that they are presently using until such time as the Court action has been finally resolved. If there is any ambiguity in the re-draft of the Stipulation in this regard, or if you or any of the attorneys receiving this letter have a different understanding, I would expect to receive notice to such effect prior to the signing of the Stipulation.

I feel safe in saying that the individual Boards of Directors of the five defendant water companies will authorize the execution of the Stipulation immediately upon word from yourself and Ed Clyde that the Plaintiffs' respective Boards of Directors have met, considered the matter, and are agreeable to signing the Stipulation. I am assuming that at this point the State Engineer and his attorney will be agreeable to joining in the Stipulation if all of the other parties to the action do so.

Please advise at your earliest convenience.
