Dear Stan:

Reference is made to our telephone conversation of today's date. It is my understanding that you will set this matter for some kind of conference or hearing prior to the commencement of the coming irrigation season.

However, I take this means of advising you of what my files show with regard to the current status of this matter.

On August 9, 1978, I went to Salt Lake City and conferred with Stan Green and Don Norseth. I allowed Mr. Norseth to copy my office memorandum dated July 22, 1978. On October 23, Don called and advised me that he had checked all of the records in his office and did not find anything substantially different from what mine had shown. He stated that he was sending an engineer to Piute County, that same day, to check further.

On October 13, 1979, I called both Stan Green and yourself and was advised that a conference or a hearing was to be held in October. At that time I was assured that the following method of distribution of the Raymond Fick right would continue until the hearing or conference referred to and until a decision was made by the State Engineer. The method of distribution referred to is the distribution order which Don Norseth advised me had been issued to Mr. Scott Smith; said method of distribution being as follows: That Mr. Fick was to receive the amount of water decreed on page 8 of the Cox Decree and that the 1.39 c.f.s. would be pro-rated between the Dobson and Cannon rights on a basis of their respective ownership of the acreage described in Bacon's Bible. The stock water was to be divided one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) to Dobson and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) to the Cannon rights.

I write this letter for the purpose of requesting that you confirm the method of distribution as agreed to by you and Stan Green on October 13, 1979, or, in the alternative, furnish me with reasons why such should not be the case.
