

STRAWBERRY WATER USERS ASSOCIATION
ANNUAL STOCKHOLDERS MEETING
January 28, 1984

At the end of the year 1983 there was 271,680 acre feet of active storage in the Strawberry Reservoir, this is 27,080 acre feet more than at the close of the year 1982.

The net inflow of water over evaporation into Strawberry Reservoir in the Calendar Year 1983 was 176,957 acre feet, as compared to 122,115 acre feet net inflow for the Calendar Year 1982.

The total water drawn from storage from the Strawberry Reservoir in the Irrigation Season 1983 was 9,931 acre feet. This amount of water drawn from storage from the Reservoir includes 604 acre feet of water the Bureau Of Reclamation requested release through the Strawberry Tunnel for the construction work at the East Portal. The total water drawn from storage from Strawberry Reservoir in 1982 was 47,415 acre feet.

We started to draw water from the Strawberry Reservoir for Irrigation on July 1, 1983, then the East Portal control gates were closed for the season on August 19, 1983 because of rain and no demand for water.

The Strawberry Tunnel was inspected on October 6, 1983 with no great change in the tunnel since the last inspection that was on October 12, 1982.

The total water the Central Utah Water Conservancy District has on storage in the Strawberry Reservoir as of December 31, 1983 is 0 acre feet.

The total water diverted into Strawberry Valley through the Currant Creek feeder canal for the 1983 season was 170 acre feet, as compared to 3,367 acre feet diverted in 1982.

The total precipitation at the East Portal for the Irrigation Year 1983 was 37.14 inches, as compared to 36.04 inches for the Irrigation Season 1982. The total precipitation at the Spanish Fork Power Plant for the Irrigation Year 1983 was 31.12 inches, as compared to 30.05 inches for the Irrigation Year 1982.

The average water content in the Snow on the three Snow Courses in Strawberry Valley as of January 1, 1984 was 242% of the 1963-77 15 year average, as compared to 150% of the 15 year average last year at this time.

A summary of all water delivered to the Appropriators in the Spanish Fork River Distribution System in 1983 was,
