

Spanish Fork, Utah  
Feb. 15, 1949

Minutes of a meeting of the water users of the Spanish Fork river were held Feb. 15, 1949 in the Spanish Fork Library Building. This meeting was called by the State Engineer but no one from that office was present. L.P. Thomas acted as chairman and Willard Peterson as secretary. The call of the meeting was read by the secretary. The minutes of the last annual water users meeting held Feb. 17, 1948 were read. Albert Swenson made the motion and seconded by Arthur Finley that the minutes be accepted as read. Motion carried.

The financial report from the State Engineer's office for 1948 was read by the secretary. Roy Creer made the motion and seconded by Arthur Finley the financial report be accepted as read. Motion carried.

Mr. Thomas said the next order of business is that of selecting a river commissioner. Arthur Finley made the motion and seconded by Roy Creer we recommend J. Wayne Francis to the State Engineer to be appointed river commissioner for 1949. Motion carried.

The appointment of upper river commissioner was discussed. Labon Harding made motion and seconded by Albert Swenson this appointment be left with the Joint Committee. Motion carried.

Mr. Francis spoke of the gates in the ditches in the canyon and said those men who do not now have suitable gates should be compelled to install them in their ditched as it would save both time and work and also water.

The budget was then discussed. Arthur Finley made the motion and seconded by Labon Harding the budget for 1949 be set as of 1948. Motion carried.

Mr. Francis suggested to the Joint Committee to instruct the man who is selected as upper river commissioner on his duties.


Arthur Finley made motion to adjourn. Seconded by Roy Creer. Carried.
