Meeting with the State Engineer, joint river committee, Strawberry Water Users Association irrigation board, and others held in the SWUA office at 11:00 A.M.

Invocation - Wallace Sorensen

Alan Galt read a letter from the state about this meeting and its agenda. Minutes from the 1988 meeting were read and approved. Alan went over the 1988 expenditures report from the state (see attached copy). Reed Christmas moved that the report be accepted. Motion passed. There were questions about why \$3,600.00 had been budgeted for health and life insurance and only \$2,892.64 were spent.

Lynn Mendenhall gave the following report:

There are 69,000 plus ac/ft. of storage water as of January 1. The tunnel was open from May 10 to Oct. 8. The CUWCD has drawn water from Dec. 2 to date and they plan on bringing 25,000 ac/ft. down to Utah Lake, during the non-irrigation season.

The CUWCD has brought down 17,000 ac/ft. to date, they plan to increase flows to 250 cfs on April 1. The water shed was now close to average on the snow courses.

The 1989 budget was reviewed. Questions arose about the \$100 for the bond, health insurance, and the CUWCD's share of the expenses. Reed Rindlisbacker moved that the budget be accepted. Ernest Hanks seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Lynn Mendenhall and Ron Davis were recommended for their same jobs.

The CUWCD was to have 6,000 ac/ft. for rent in 1989 at \$5.00/ac.ft. The SWUA agreed to charge no O & M service charge on this water.

State Engineer representatives asked about any changes on the directors on the board.

Lee Sim explained that the state was going to standardize the various river commissioner report forms and move toward a computerized records system state-wide.
