Dear Don:

Enclosed herewith are the elevations of Utah Lake and its capacity from January 1, 1975, through March 31, 1975.

As you are aware, the gates at Utah Lake were closed at the end of the irrigation season of 1974 and remained in that state until February 10, 1975. These gates have remained open since February 10, 1975, and will remain open until such time that the pumped water exceeds the gravity flow discharge.

It is my feeling that Utah Lake will not reach compromise due to the fact that we are now discharging 500 c.f.s. plus through the Jordan Narrows and we anticipate irrigation season starting in late April. The snow surveys which I have received indicate that the drainage for Utah Lake is or about normal. Therefore, if normal temperatures prevail, the inflow into Utah Lake should not exceed the discharge and compromise should not be exceeded.
