RE: District Water Rights in Utah Lake

Dear Bob:

The District is continuing to investigate methods of best utilizing its available water in Utah Lake to meet project purposes under the Bonneville Unit of the Central Utah Project. The District's Utah Lake water is the 25,000 acre-feet of primary water under water right No. 57-7624 and the 57,073 acre feet of secondary water under water rights 59-14, 59-15 and 59-20. The District fully intends to use these water rights in the future upon the approval of appropriate change or exchange applications on these rights. Until our studies are complete, however, we ask that you delay further action on water right exchange applications E3100 and E3101 pertaining to the above referenced water rights.

For water year 1994, the District will not need to divert and use water available under the above referenced Utah Lake water rights. Accordingly, please instruct the river commissioner to leave this water in Utah Lake. By leaving the water in Utah Lake, we understand that you will be able to reduce the level of the conversion and primary storage lines under the Utah Lake Distribution Plan to account for the reduced demand. We anticipate that this action will result in the District and others holding upstream storage rights in the Provo River Drainage being able to convert system storage sooner and in a greater quantity than would otherwise occur.
