RE: Distribution of Waters From Utah Lake

Dear Brad:

The Division of Water Rights received a letter from the Central Utah Water Conservancy District (CUWCD) which requests that the State Engineer not deliver their water from Utah Lake and/or the Jordan River this season under water right numbers 57-7624 and 59-14, 15 and 20. These water rights represent 82,073 acre-feet, or about 27% of the demand from Utah Lake. You are hereby directed to cease any deliveries of these waters under the above cited water rights. Any water which has been delivered to these rights prior to receipt of this letter should be reported immediately to this office.

As a result of CUWCD's request, the Division of Water Rights is currently re-examining the water right demands on Utah Lake for the current irrigation season, as it relates to the Interim Water Distribution Plan for the Utah Lake Drainage Basin. We plan to develop a revised table on the criteria of when system storage can be converted to priority storage (Table 3 of the plan). The revised table would reflect the decreased demand on Utah Lake. The table will be mailed out to water users and River Commissioners with the June 15 Water Supply Update.
