Re: EXCHANGE APPLICATIONS E3100 AND E3101

Dear Bob:

As you know the Central Utah Water Conservancy District filed the above referenced Exchange Applications on certain water rights the district has purchased in Utah Lake. Although the district intends to use these water rights in the future upon the eventual approval of the pending Exchange Applications, it will have no need to divert and use water available under these water during the 1993 water year. Therefore the 25,000 acre feet of primary water available under water right 57-7624 and the 57,073 acre feet of secondary water available under water rights 59-14, 59-15 and 59-20 will not be called for by the district this water year.

Accordingly, the district requests the State Engineer to instruct his river commissioner to leave this water in Utah Lake. As a result of the reduced demand on the water resources in Utah Lake, we understand that the State Engineer will be able to reduce the level of the conversion line this water year under the Utah Lake Distribution Plan to account for this reduced demand. We anticipate that this action will result in that the district, as well as others holding upstream storage rights in the Provo River Drainage, will be able to convert the system storage remaining in the upstream reservoirs to priority storage for this water year.
