distribution plan. At this time, all system storage upstream of  
Utah Lake has been converted to priority storage.

The attached system storage conversion graph reflects the  
modified conversion criteria as developed in the June 15 water  
supply update. The total system storage, 373,160 acre-feet,  
illustrated on the graph is stored in Utah Lake.

This water supply update will be the last one to be sent out  
until this coming October when another water supply update will be  
issued.




