Subject: Deer Creek Reservoir System Storage

Lee,

I have heard rumor that the Board of Canal Presidents is going to request that approximately 4,700 acre-feet of system storage be released from Deer Creek Reservoir. The Central Utah Water Conservancy District would like to exchange this water for Bonneville Unit water under the Deer Creek Jordanelle Operating Agreement paragraph 15. The system storage water currently in Deer Creek would then become CUP priority storage.

In a letter sent to Jim Riley on March 24, 2004 the District reported that 16,797 acre-feet of Strawberry Reservoir water had been conveyed to Utah Lake. Additional deliveries were made prior to the beginning of irrigation season bringing the total conveyed water to 21,206 acre-feet subject to incremental evaporation in Utah Lake. Each month a summary has been sent to your office detailing these deliveries. As of August 31, 2004 a total of 7,331 acre-feet of CUP temporary ag water had been delivered to South Utah County. The district should receive credit for approximately 2,900 acre-feet of return flows in Utah Lake. We would like to request a copy of the Division's Utah Lake accounting report to determine our incremental evaporation. I request that the exchange of the system storage water in Deer Creek Reservoir be made from the water conveyed from Strawberry Reservoir to Utah Lake under the terms and conditions of the Deer Creek Jordanelle Operating Agreement.

I would be happy to meet with you at anytime to discuss these matters. Thank you for your consideration.
