Re: Reductions in releases from Utah Lake Storage

Dear Brad:

The following figures reflect the new maximum diversion rate for the canal companies on the Utah Lake/Jordan River Distribution System. The diversions have been adjusted to account for change applications which have transferred a portion of the water right of the respective companies. For the 2000 irrigation season, you are directed to reduce the diversion to each of the canals by the indicated amount or percentage if the full amount is not being diverted to release the water.

A portion of the Amwest Exploration Galen Canal water right has been moved to the Draper Canal which added 6.755 cfs to the Draper Irrigation Company diversion. 8.55. cfs was to be reduced for Eagle Mountain. The net is a reduction of 1.8 cfs. for Draper.
