#### COMMISSIONERS REPORT 1991

Weber River Water Commissioner, E. Blaine Johnson expressed his appreciation for his Deputies. They did all that was expected of them. We didn't get a great deal of snow, but the rain in April and May saved us from a dismal water year. At the beginning of the water year, Smith & Morehouse filled @ 7,600AF, Rockport @ 60,860AF, Echo filled @ 74,000AF, Lost Creek @ 15,140AF, and East Canyon @ 40,670AF. At the end of the water year, Smith & Morehouse was empty, Rockport @ 41,380AF, Echo @ 24,890AF, Lost Creek @ 10,150AF, and East Canyon @ 32,950AF. In all, 1991 was a good water year. As of January 10, 1992 the reservoirs on the Weber River System are 60 - 70% of normal. He further stated that we should fill Echo, and the rest depend on the weather. D. Earl Harris made a motion to accept the Commissioner's Report. Floyd Baham seconded the motion, and all voted in favor.

#### PROPOSED BUDGET 1992

Joseph Dawson, Chairman of the Weber River Water Rights Committee presented the 1992 Proposed Budget of \$96,983.00. The budget in entirety was read by the Secretary. Chairman Dawson explained that there had been 4% salary increase for the Commissioner and his Deputies. He further stated that the Committee had recommended that the assessment be increased to coincide with the budget, and leave the reserve in tact. Dennis Wright made a motion to accept the budget and set the assessment accordingly. D. Earl Harris seconded the motion and the vote carried unanimously.

#### RECOMMENDING COMMISSIONER 1992

Joseph Dawson made a motion that we retain Commissioner Johnson and his Deputies for 1992. Floyd Baham seconded and all voted in favor. Chairman Dawson explained to Lee Sim that the four committeemen whose terms expired had been re-elected for another three year term. Chairman Dawson further stated that the Committee has made it a policy to take a field trip each year to various areas on the Weber River System. He also stated that we now attend four meetings a year and we have been quite active. He thanked Lee Sim and John Mann for attending the meeting.

#### ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the same was adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
