Distribution Meeting  
January 12, 1988

Drainage is 51% of average as of January 1, 1988. Weber Basin has 22,500 storage in Rockport and Smith Morehouse, Lost Creek 14,210, and East Canyon 15,469. Total Echo credits are 36,481 and D&W credits in East Canyon are 13,430. Lee Sim thanked Commissioner Johnson and his deputies for the fine job done. Dave Humphreys made a motion to accept the Commissioners report. Floyd Baham seconded and all voted in favor.

Chairman Wright of the Weber River Water Rights Committee presented the 1988 Proposed Budget of \$77,210.00. Chairman Wright recommended that the minimum distribution fee be increased to \$5.00 from the present \$2.00. He also recommended that Commissioner Johnson and his five deputies be retained for the following year of 1988.

Lee Sim stated that the River Commissioners are appointed April 1 to April 1 of each year. It is currently necessary to use reserve accounts to pay the commissioners from January thru April before the assessments come in. Dennis Wright made a motion to continue with the present method that the State Engineer is using January thru April for payment of the Commissioners. Floyd Baham seconded the motion and all voted in favor.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the same was adjourned at 1:35 p.m.
