Dear Mr. Fjeldsted:

The water sales contract with the Chalk Creek Water Distributors for 643.0 acre-feet of Weber Basin project water for irrigation purposes, on an exchange basis, has been approved on behalf of the United States. The original and duplicate original copies are enclosed for your use and for the use of the Chalk Creek Water Distributors.

This water is to replace water in the Chalk Creek area which would normally flow into Weber River below Manship Reservoir. It is our opinion the exchange can be made by delivery of replacement water from Manship Reservoir as directed by the State Engineer or his representative.

Water for this contract will be available under a future unit notice. Water may be rented to the Water Distributors until a unit notice for this water is issued, provided rental water is available.
