

MINUTES OF THE 1999 GEORGE CREEK
WATER USERS MEETING

WATER RIGHTS

The annual meeting of the George Creek Water Users and the Division of Water Rights was held at the home of Mike Spencer on March 16, 1999.

Bob called the meeting to order at 11:15. Those present were: Will Atkin, Bob Fotheringham, Nelson Stillwell, Mike and Sherry Spencer.

Mike read the minutes and they were approved. Bob reviewed the budget. At the time of printing, Mike hadn't collected his wages, but he has now. The budget for this coming year will be the same: \$1500.00 wage, \$115.00 social security, and \$12.00 workers comp. For a total of \$1627.00.

Mike reported that it was a good water year. We had plenty of snow and also spring rains. The creek held up really well through July and August. He thinks there will be adequate snow pack for this coming season.

Nelson recommended to keep Mike on as commissioner.

Will and Bob showed Mike the Division of Water Rights home page on the Internet and also different things pertaining to water.

Nelson inquired about the waste water running into Idaho. He wondered if it was filed on, would it affect his water rights. No. He also wondered about the possibility of tapping into the main pipeline to put a new line into his field at sometime in the future. Nelson said that he hadn't gotten notice of the meeting this year. Bob was asked to check on the mailing list. The meeting adjourned at 12:10 p.m.
