MINUTES OF THE
GEORGE CREEK WATER USERS MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the George Creek Water Users and the Division of Water Rights was held on May 9, 1986, at 1:00 p.m. at the home of Mike Spencer. The meeting was called to order and untrroductions made by Kent Jones, of the Division of Water Rights. Those present were: Kent Jones, Mike Walker, John Jensen, Darwin Thompson, Stan Spencer, Guy Nontgomery, Mike Spencer, and Yale Montgomery.

The minutes of the 1985 meeting were read by Kent Jones. Corrections and additions were called for and one correction was made. George Creek Co. was delinquent, rather than Ken Rickins. Motion to approve the mintues as corrected was made by Stan Spencer and seconded by Darwin Thompson.

The financial statement was read by Kent. It was discussed that the 1985 water assessment had not yet been sent out. Kent suggested that a letter be sent to the secretary urging that it be done.

Yale moved to accept the financial atatement as read, and Mike Spencer seconded it.

Mike discussed that Karl Oman's headgate is still in disrepair, but it is anticipated that he will make repairs this year.

Guy, who is leasing Collin Booth's field this year, said that Collin's headgate is in disrepair, but the could manage with it the way it is this year.

Kent said that he would look into the snow measuring done by the State of Idaho.

Kent explained to Mike (and his wife) that he should be preparing his own yearly reports and should budget extra money to do so. Stan suggested that \$25. should be adequate, and this was agreed upon.

It was agreed that \$1540. would be the budget for this coming year.

The 1986 budget was set as follows:

Mike Spencer was nominated by Stan Spencer to be the commissioner for the coming year. Darwin Thompson seconded it.

It was decided that a letter should be sent to Collin Booth, or anyone having headgate problems in the future, stating that his headgate is in disrepair to divert adequate water, so it would be a matter of record.
