

MINUTES OF THE  
GEORGE CREEK WATER USERS MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the George Creek Water User's and the Division of Water Rights was held on March 9, 1984 at the home of Mike Spencer. The meeting was called to order by Michael Turnipseed of the Division of Water Rights at 1:25 p.m.

The minutes of the 1983 meeting were read by Jerry Bronicel. Corrections and additions were called for. A motion was made to approve the minutes as read, seconded, and passed.

The Financial Statement was read by Michael Turnipseed and reviewed. It was stated that there had been no bond for last year. The budget was accepted to be the same as previous years. It was stated that the assessments were not late.

Commissioner Mike Spencer read the Commissioners Report and stated there were no problems on the system. Carl Oman's weir has not been fixed. There was quite a bit of erosion up the canyon by Boyd Taylor's diversion. Stillwell had bought 40 acres of land. The last few years there has been very high run-off. There was some talk about additional filings since all of the water is now controlled by two parties, namely Spencer's and Richen's.
