

MINUTES OF THE 1998 GEORGE CREEK

WATER USERS MEETING

The annual meeting of the George Creek Water Users and the Division of Water Rights was held at the home of Mike Spencer on April 7, 1998.

Lee Sims called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Those present were: Bob Fotheringham, Lee Sims, Mike Spencer, Nelson Stillwell, Nolan Oman, Carl Spencer and Sherry Spencer.

Sherry read the minutes and they were approved. Lee went through the financial statement and it was approved.

Lee explained that as a commissioner Mike would need to be on worker's comp, and would need to be paid monthly.

Mike inquired if it would be possible to be on state health insurance. Lee said he would look into it.

It was decided to stay affiliated with the Division of Water Rights and comply with employment policy.

Mike reported that it was a good water year and all headgates are in good repair.

Nelson inquired about the reliability of the dam. The consensus was that the dam is in good condition.

Nolan moved to keep Mike on as commissioner, and Nelson seconded. The budget was set at \$1500.00 wage, \$115.00 social security, and \$12.00 workers comp for a total of \$1627.

Nelson had some questions about the ditch in his field and about a spring and drilling a well in his field.

There was some discussion on "total maximum daily loads" and how it would apply to us.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30. Refreshments were served.
