Gentlemen:

Enclosed is a copy of an order entered April 27, 1961, by Judge Tuckett. You will note that it has settled the matter of priorities as among these parties, and these, of course, should be used in the proposed adjudication suit.

You will also note that the matter of a water commissioner and the matter of measuring devices is essentially left to your office. We do not believe that the stream can be administered unless the major diversion points have headgates and measuring weirs. It would be appreciated if you would have this checked in the field and issue an order to each of the persons as to the type of headgate and measuring weir you would recommend for the various points of diversion. If anyone is dissatisfied therewith, he, of course, can have it reviewed in the courts, but we would appreciate it if you would get the matter started.
