That he is a citizen of the United States and a resident of Roosevelt, Duchesne County, State of Utah, over fifty years of age.

That in February, 1911, and subsequent thereto, he was located and ran his sheep in that portion of the country now known as Duchesne County, State of Utah, and particularly the area generally known as the "Sand Wash";

That he was and is personally acquainted with the condition of that certain stream and stream bed known as "Sand Wash", and in particular that part of said Sand Wash situated in Township 1 and 2 South, Range 3 West, Uintah Special Meridian;

That this deponent says, of his own knowledge, that the said "Sand Wash" and its tributaries in February, 1911, and until about the year 1913, was a dry wash and ran no water whatsoever, except after rain storms and the melting of snow in the springtime; that during the remainder of the years prior to 1913, the area in which the said Sand Wash is situate was a desert country. That seepage of water commenced in said wash about the year 1913 and has continually increased since that time.
