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I have not seen or talked to Jim White since your letter to me on May 23,2002. I did leave a message for Jim to contact me, but I have not heard from him. I presume he is still willing to be the River Commissioner. I still have dip-stick type staff gauges in place at the discharge points from both creeks at the reservoir. We still have Aqua-pod measuring devices at both locations. I have now,also, installed staff gauges at both locations which are manually readable from outside the locked aqua-pod compartments. This will make it easier for the River Commissioner to take the readings. Therefore, I do not see the need for Jim to have a key. However, if you still feel there is a need for Jim to have access to the other measuring devices, I will give him a key. Let me know. I must emphasize, these staff gauges are for our convenience, and to make the Job easier for the River Commissioner to take readings for flow varification. I will not accept any disputed readings of any of these devices taken by Mr. Douglass. If He can't accept these readings as they are, He should look to the River Commissioner readings for varification. I will gladly address any discrepancies in flow readings taken by the State or the River Commissioner. I will show Jim White where these staff gauges are and how to read them if/when I see him.
