Dear Mr. White:

I am writing to thank you for all that you have been able to do to help us over the past few years and to ask if you will be able to continue to serve as the commissioner for the Granite Creek / Red Cedar Creek Water Commissioner as part of your work as the Deputy Sheriff in the area.

If you are able to continue in this capacity, could I ask a favor of you? There appears to be a need, even in dry years, to verify the digital water measurement data that Glen Alfred collects and sends to our office. In our meeting with Buck Douglass and Glen Alfred yesterday, they agreed that if you could read both staff gages at the reservoir each time that your deputy sheriff responsibilities brought you into the area it would be adequate to verify the digital data.

If you can do this, would you please record the following information each time you take a staff gage reading: the staff gage reading, the stream name, the date, and the time of day. Would you also please report this information to our office each time that you make a reading. There are several ways that you could send in this report:



It would be very helpful if you could do this; it would allow us to verify the digital data each time Glen sends it in.

Glen said that last year he showed you where the staff gages are located at the hydro power plant and at the pipe outlet from Red Cedar Creek. He also said that he provided you with the keys you need to gain access to these staff gages. If there is any further information that you need relating to taking these readings please contact me and we will provide the information or make the necessary arrangements for you to get it.

Please let me know as soon as possible whether or not you can continue in this position. If not, we will need to look at other options.
