Dear Jim:

Last week I talked with Sheriff Philips concerning the arrangement to have you act as the water commissioner. I explained you would do this when your duties as a deputy sheriff took you into the area. I explained that there were four meters to read and record the water use. My estimate was that it should not take too much of your time on each trip. Sheriff Philips offered for this year to have you act in this capacity without requiring the water users to pay any compensation to the Sheriff's office. We will see how things go; if the position requires more of your time than we have anticipated, we might consider some kind of reimbursement arrangement at that time.

On this basis, we will appoint you as the water commissioner without putting you on the state payroll or setting up a budget for the distribution system. Enclosed is the card verifying your appointment.

Also enclosed are the addressed, stamped envelopes for you to use in sending the power house printout and the aquapod data module in to our office each month.

You will need to talk with Glen Allred to get the other data module. You should also talk with him about how to replace the modules in the aquapod; they apparently do not come out very easily. For right now, please exchange the data pods and send them into our office every month. Eventually, we may have you exchange them only twice an irrigation season.
