Dear Mr. Mann:

It's time for our annual complaint about Red Cedar Corporation taking more than their share of water.

Since April 3, 1998, Red Cedar Creek has been delivering 6 c.f.s. to the reservoir. We have no idea how much water has been diverted from Granite Creek because the staff gauge has been removed.

Glen Allred called last week and said he would be taking all of Granite Creek so they can keep their reservoir full.

If Red Cedar Corporation was only diverting 4 c.f.s. from Granite Creek for this time, they would have used their tariff by now. We can be assured that they were diverting way in excess of that for power generation purposes.

There is water coming down to the main road out of Red Cedar at this time, more than enough water to maintain the reservoir without cutting us off of Granite Creek. We want to see the State Engineers office take some action on this as soon as possible.
