Dear Sir:

Based on the information in our records, there was never a permit issued by the State for a reservoir on the Skutumpah Field Wash. The down stream users protested the construction, and the State Engineer upheld this protest. Our records indicate that no permit was issued by the State for a reservoir in this area.

From our observations over the years, this reservoir's dyke and over-flow standpipe have been raised numerous times on water filings 85-248 and 85-249.

In reference to the letter received from the State Engineer's office, January 13, 2003 concerning the Skutumpah Field Reservoir, TLB Ltd, to our knowledge they have not met any of the conditions stated on page 4.

We the Down Stream users request that no construction or alternations be permitted on the said dam, or in the wash, until a permit is issued by the State Engineer, specifying the amount of water that can be impounded to satisfy water rights granted by 85-248 and 85-249.
