Dear Mr. Smith:

We recently received a letter from Mrs. Linda Swapp Kollander expressing concerns about the BLM's stockwatering system in Sink Valley which provides water to the Heaton Brothers and the Carrolls. Mrs. Kollander reports there is no measuring device to record the amount of water used by the system and that the valves at the tanks do not function properly to shut off once the tanks are full.

Change application 85-848 (a16395) which was approved in 1992 covers the stockwatering use for this system. We would remind you that in granting approval of the application the memorandum decision imposed several conditions. Two of the requirements included in the conditions are:

1. The water collection system and pipeline must be kept in proper operating order to ensure that there will be no wasting of water from this source.

2. . . ., the total use by the Bureau of Land Management is limited to 4.73 acre-feet of water per annum.

Continued use of water under this right is based on compliance with the conditions of the memorandum decision.

You are requested to comply with the conditions of the memorandum decision as soon as possible. Your response stating the measures taken to comply with the conditions will be appreciated.
